

TECHWELL Frequently Asked Questions

What is this programme about?	The TECHWELL (Technology with Health and Well Being) programme is a series of courses, workshops and one-to-ones in: IT: Basics of AI, data, use/fix your computer, Word, PowerPoint, etc. Employability: CV writing, Portfolio building, job hunting Health & Well Being: Resilience, selfcare & confidence building tactics.
How long is the programme?	 The programme lasts 6 weeks. First 2 weeks: face-to-face courses/workshops, Mon- Fri 10am to 2pm. Last 4 weeks: Online courses completion, tailored 1 to 1 phone, office or online (Zoom / Google Meet) meetings with a session staff for 1h+ a week.

What are the Eligibility requirements	 Have been in the UK for at least 3 years Have the right to live and work in the UK Be aged 16 or over Live and/or work within Greater Manchester Know how to use a computer and go online
How long has the programme been running?	We have now run the programme over 20 times / cohorts. We have had nearly 200 participants so far. 100% of willing participants are supported to take the next step, and our last cohort gained the skills and confidence to pursue work-related placements, training, apprenticeships, self-employment, or paid work - with ongoing support available via our online programme resources.
What will you need for an ID check?	 We will ask for your national insurance number We ask for ID to check proof of age/birthdate, UK residency. You can share one or more of the following: passport, driving licence, birth certificate, council tax bill, utility bill, bank statement, UK residence permit or indefinite leave to remain or current work visa, benefit letter, GP letter, or any other ID/info that also confirms eligibility.



What incentives are there for completing the full programme

- FREE set of digital, employability and Health & well-being courses
- Prestigious Certificate of Completion (see below). If you don't complete the programme but attend 50% or more, you can a simple page certifying your attendance. Note that lateness affects your attendance.



- FREE online access for 6 months to the online versions of all courses you take with us.
- FREE 6-month online access to relevant extra courses with tutor support 1 hour a week for 1 month.
- A completed, ATS-friendly, reviewed CV for every participant who provides a current CV and completes the course.

Is my travel reimbursed?

- Ingeus participants should claim travel costs directly from their RAs.

What is considered completing the programme?

- Attending at least 80% of the face-to-face courses
- · Completing online any courses you did not attend face to face
- Completing 4 additional online only courses
- Completed CV
- Sending at least one job application
- Progression to your next step to your goals: e.g., Further training, University, Volunteer/Intern, Apprenticeship, Job/Employment

Is the programme accredited?

As per the funders' requirements, the programme is not accredited. However, you will receive a certificate of completion or attendance, depending on the criteria stated above.

What additional courses can I have access to thanks to the programme?

Once you complete the programme's courses, we can give you access for 6 months to online courses with 1h per week Google Meet / Phone tutor support for the first month. These are the courses
